



## Reminders from the Maintenance Div.



The Town of Galena has installed a new Water Metering System in the last year and a half. This is a computer system that can help you the homeowner, as well as the Town identify leaks from the meter and throughout your house. In the last year we have spoken with quite a few of our residents and advised them of possible leaks. In most every circumstance they have found something running or a leak in their piping. This has helped them save money on their water bill, as well as the Town not having to treat extra water that is being wasted. We thank all our customers for helping us help you. Also, just as a reminder, the resident is not to open the meter lid. If you need to have your meter lid opened, please contact our Maintenance Dept. 410-648-5151 Ext. 304. There is a fee to have the pit opened. There is an antenna that is attached to the lid that can be damaged if proper care is not take when opening the lid. Please see (Resolution 2018-02). These meters are also capable of detecting when someone is tampering with the meter. Please see (Ordinance 2018-01, specifically #173-4 Interference with water or sewer system). Thanks again for helping the Town of Galena maintain a high-quality Water and Waste Water System.

Lastly the Town Maintenance Div. would like to ask that when inclement weather is forecasted, please park all your vehicles in your driveways so that we can keep the Town roads open. We realize that this can be challenging, but if there are multiple vehicles, you can always park in the parking lot at the Playground and at the Virginia Ave. parking lot.
